 - -RCPT / Sharepoint access and Emergency Planning Survey should, after a couple of snafus, be provided by next week.
 - -Lake County has hired a contractor for data collection in preparation for development of a Tactical Interoperable Communications Plan (TICP). The Interoperable Communications Council will be managing this project.
 - -Lake County will be hosting the EOC Operations and Management Course and the EOC-ICS Interface Course, tentatively March 30, 31, and April 1.
 - -Lake County, Grainger, Lincolnshire-Riverwoods Fire Protection District, and the Lake-Cook Regional Critical Incident Partnership are conducting a full-scale exercise on and around Saturday, June 19.
 - -Weather radio grant program (Like STAR, but more flexible) through IESMA will be released soon. Jurisdictions may apply to receive case-lots of weather radios for facilities in their community.
 - -Guidance for the IESMA EOC Technology Grant program continues to be refined. By next week it is expected that there will be a pre-qualification application on the IESMA website, followed by a grant information workshop at the IESMA conference in Peoria in April.
 - -Kent just attended a FEMA NIMS workgroup on Incident Management, and will have information to share and discuss at the March EMCC meeting.
